The National Ocean Sciences Bowl® (NOSB) broadens STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) learning and **cultivates our future ocean leaders and your future employees!** The NOSB is an annual academic competition that takes place across the United States through a combination of Regional Bowls and a National Finals Competition. The program engages high school students in ocean and freshwater science learning. It also inspires and prepares them to be the next generation of knowledgeable community members, environmental leaders, and Earth system science employees!

The ocean plays a critical role in weather, climate, human health, food security, national security, and the economy. Ocean science covers all STEM disciplines, applies them in a real-world context, and brings to bear the technological and engineering innovations required to work in and with the ocean environment.

Research from the National Survey of Science and Mathematics Education states that many high school students in the United States do not have the opportunity to study ocean, earth, and environmental science as part of their formal coursework. Yet in the next 10 years, environmental, geoscience, and related engineering and technical careers will grow by 10 percent*.

We need to engage students in these disciplines at a younger age when they are making career decisions. Since 1998, the **NOSB has prepared 40,000 students** to take advantage of the increasing job opportunities in ocean science and other STEM fields.

Long-term program evaluation highlights how the NOSB continues to inspire the next generation of researchers and scientists. Our most recent evaluations of participating students show that:

- **91% increased their interest in science**
- **75% agreed they are more likely to consider a career in a scientific field**
- **66% agreed they are more likely to consider an ocean science career**
- **89% agreed they are much more aware of ocean science career options**
- **Students felt they benefited from a strong sense of validation and belonging, reinforcing that they were part of something meaningful and connected to a broader community**

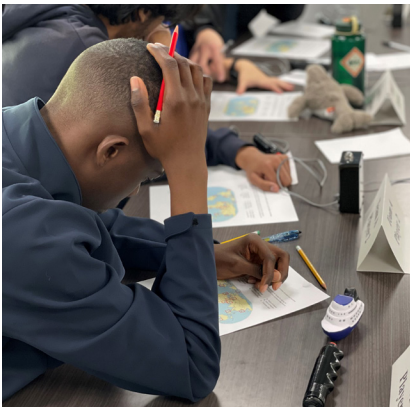

I grew up in rural New Hampshire with two older sisters, both of whom competed at the local (Nor'Easter) and national level on our high school's NOSB team. Despite living multiple hours from the seacoast, my sisters fiercely studied for our annual Bowl, with our parents buying Sverdrup's textbooks and the three of us jointly making literally hundreds of index cards with example questions. We spent whole summers quizzing each other on ocean science. By the time I started high school, I knew the ins-and-outs of pycnoclines and shallow water waves!

I later led my school's team to two national-level competitions and was inspired at one of these competitions to pursue scientific research as a career. I am writing to you now as a PhD student at Columbia University, where I study motor neuron changes in the context of Lou Gehrig's disease. I can confidently draw a line from my first after-school Ocean Bowl practice to my current position in scientific research and I am sure that – in addition to the many stories of former NOSB students becoming marine biologists and ecologists – my story of ocean-science-to-medical-science is one of many.
